101 West 14th Street's design by ODA Architecture makes a dramatic statement on a corner where Greenwich Village meets Chelsea. The bank building formerly on-site was demolished, but a mural dating back to 1954 was carefully removed and rescued. (So was a clock face with a Banksy stencil - might it be part of this summer's exhibition?)

Nearly half the apartments inside are duplex units, and all units feature contactless entry, motorized wall-to-wall and floor-to-ceiling windows and shades, open-concept layouts, generous closet space, kitchens with marble countertops and integrated Gaggenau and Bosch appliances, and pristine baths. Several units have private terraces, and all residents have access to the building's lush courtyard and rooftop deck with outdoor kitchen and incredible skyline views. Indoor amenities include a state-of-the-art gym, lounge, and private storage for purchase.





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
