

## Inside Zendaya's 'Euphoric' \$5M NYC waterfront condo

Zendaya is in love ... with Brooklyn!

The superstar singer and actress — in the news this week for her offscreen romance with Tom Holland, her co-star in the upcoming "Spider-Man: No Way Home" film, the third in a trilogy — bought a \$4.9 million condo at Quay Tower last December, Gimme can exclusively reveal.

The actress, who also stars in the upcoming "Dune" remake and in "Euphoria" on Netflix, was taken by the stunning city skyline and water views that the skypad offered.

She also loved the fact that there was a private entrance with its own private elevator line for some of the units.

While there are five units on Zendaya's floor, the private elevator only opens to her unit, a source said. While the developer, Robert Levine, would not comment on Zendaya's purchase, he did say that he learned how valuable the amenity was when Mariah Carey lived in one of his buildings in Tribeca and had to use the freight elevator to avoid attention.

Sources say Zendaya was interested in living in the Brooklyn condo and that her security team approves of the setup.

But as her popularity soars — she now has 102 million followers on Instagram — she is spending most of her time on the West Coast and has since rented out the unit, which was last asking \$16,000 a month, according to StreetEasy.

The three-bedroom, 2½-bathroom unit is 2,050 square feet and features stellar Manhattan skyline and New York Harbor views from every room.

Details include an open, corner living and dining room, a windowed chef's kitchen and wide plank oak floors. There's also a main bedroom with a formal dressing area, lots of storage and an ensuite spa-like bathroom with a soaking tub and radiant heated floors.

Rumors about Zendaya and Holland launched two years ago when "The Greatest Showman" star met Holland on the set of "Spider-Man: Homecoming." At the time, the actors — who play Peter Parker and his girlfriend MJ — said they were just friends.

A third film in the trilogy is slated, though Zendaya hinted this may be her last "Spider-Man" film in a recent interview.

Reality TV star broker Ryan Serhant is now leading sales in the building, which is around 40% sold.
